The ideal candidate has an advanced degree (in French and/or in education), has near native fluency in French, and has experience integrating technology into the classroom setting. In addition, the candidate should have the capacity to work with students of varying ages and abilities and to work collaboratively with colleagues to develop learning activities that enhance the four language skills, encourage critical thinking and broaden the students' appreciation of culture.
